
Fumigation Prep



Food: All food or ingestible items (including pet food, medicines, candy, etc.), should be removed or doublebagged with Nylofume bags. They are included with our service, and we can provide those bags if requested. We highly recommend removing as much of these items as possible.

Collected Water: Any standing potable water in your home should be drained prior to fumigation. This includes fish tanks, recycled rainwater canisters, etc.





Physical Home Prep: Clear 18" around perimeter of structure so tent can get a proper seal. Trim any foliage, remove any debris, and retract any awnings to make this possible. Disable your alarm system. Turn gas off at main valve. Water any outside plants within 18" the night prior to treatment.

Fumigation Prep

We are proud to handle your home as delicately and safely as possible. If there is any issue with way we've left your home, please let us know and we will do what we can to make it right. That being said, **we do not assume liability for:**

Damage: Damage to roofing tiles, awnings, gutters, windows/window screens, solar panels, gates, attic entries, plant-life in or around the structure, or the structures paint. Please make the proper arrangements prior to your fumigation to ensure these things work properly, can be worked around, and do not need to be forcibly opened or removed.





Scheduling: We will give you an estimate for the time your structure must remain vacant and when we will begin/end service. Those time frames can change depending on wind, rain, traffic, or other factors. If the time changes significantly, we will inform you and try to accommodate you the best we can.

For liability purposes, you are not permitted on site once the fumigation starts until we clear the structure.

Vandalism: We secure the structure with the keys provided. Unfortunately, sometimes vandals take advantage of an obviously empty home.

Pre-treatment

Make arrangements for the structure to be vacant at least 3 days Double bag all ingestibles (foods, medicines, etc) in Nylofume bags Make sure you can provide us with a physical key for the fumigation Make sure the perimeter of your home has 18" of clearance If you have natural gas, arrange for it to be shut off at the main valve Extinguish any pilot lights in the structure Disable your alarm system Retract awnings, valances, or shades Remove any TV antennae or satellite dishes if necessary Detach any fences that extend more than 5 feet from the structure Water any plants within 18" of the structure the night before service If a crawl space is present, clear it of wildlife the night before service

Post-treatment

Do not return to home until it has been cleared for safe re-entry
It is not necessary to wash dishes or clothes upon re-entry
